These wines are drawn from the cask into 5 gallon stainless steel kegs. We keep the wine fresh under a pressurized gas system and dispense it by the glass. This eliminates bottles and boxes. It also reduces the carbon footprint by reducing the transportation weight by 50%. I hope you enjoy our selection of 4 reds and 3 whites. They are offered by the glass and the carafe.

Chardonnay

- Robert Mondavi Chardonnay – Napa Valley 2007 44
Lush tropical fruit, floral and spice. This 100% Napa Chardonnay has very rich and silky flavors.
- Lambert Bridge Chardonnay – Sonoma County 2005 46
This estate wine has nice accents of caramel and spice
- Buena Vista Chardonnay - Carneros 2008 32
The 2008 Carneros Chardonnay shows aromas of sweet vanilla, mango and pineapple fruit against a creamy, toasty background. On the palate it shows intense apple, vibrant citrus, honeydew and pear notes
- RVTZ Cellars "Bacigalupi Vineyard" Chardonnay – Russian River 2005 39
Exhibits classic fruit and mineral aromas, a rich palate and an extremely lengthy finish
Natural crisp acidity with notes of peach, vanilla and tropical fruit. Delicious wine at this price !
- Ironstone Chardonnay – Estate Grown – Sierra Foothills 2007 32
This rich Sierra Foothills chardonnay has concentrated flavors of tropical fruit with a rich butterscotch finish
- Georges du Beouf Pouilly Fuisse – France 2006 42
Pouilly Fuisse region only grows Chardonnay. This is a wonderful example of this classic French Chardonnay at a remarkable price. Racy citrus and peach flavors gain sweetness and flesh with air, finishing clean and persistent. "The 46 Diamonds Cuvée is limited to 800 cases." **GLS**

Esoteric White Wines

- Dry Creek Vineyard Estate Fume Blanc DCVS– Dry Creek 2006 36
A lovely oak aged Sauvignon Blanc is to be experienced. Medium yellow coloring is well balanced and long finish is dry with classic acidity. **GLS**
- Seven Daughters Moscato – Italy 30
Lightly sweet and effervescent, perfectly balanced with the natural aroma of the Moscato grape.
A bouquet of fresh flowers with a touch of honey is present in this wine
- Sutcliffe Rose – Colorado 36
Slightly effervescence with a crisp strawberry and melon finish

Merlot

- Sterling Vineyards Napa Valley Merlot 06 38
Deep ruby color with a spicy black cherry, blackberry, cedar and mocha overtones. Silky ripe and toasty.
- Buena Vista Merlot – Sonoma 2004 39
Beautifully balanced with aromas of cassis and roasted coffee beans, layers of fruit, and leather complemented on the palate by opulent tannins.
- St. Francis Merlot – Sonoma County 2006 40
Spicy herb and vanilla overtones, which give way to strong black fruit on the palate, nuanced with chocolate. **GLS**
- Trinchero "Chicken Ranch Vineyard" Estate Merlot – Napa 2004 43
Featuring the signature flavors for "Chicken Ranch" a beautiful earthiness and dried herbs.
Deep dark color, ripe on the nose with a hint of olives, leather and sage with ripe, lush flavors.
- Steele Stymie Founders Reserve Merlot – Lake County 2004 49
A rich, deep red firm body, aromas of chocolate, jammy fruit, tobacco and pepper. The palate reveals a rich well structured wine with red currants, anise, chocolate cherries and a touch of coffee.
- Sutcliffe Vineyards Merlot – Colorado 45
Approachable and full with acids and tannins that balance this merlot beautifully

Cabernet Sauvignon and Clarets

- Devils Lair Cabernet Blend – Margaret River, Australia 2004 37
Blended with 78% Cabernet, 19% Merlot and 3% Cabernet Franc fruit, this complex Wine shows concentrated cassis and currant aromas. Perfume and violets in the nose.
- Dussek Cabernet Sauvignon – Washington State 2004 48
This 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from Rattlesnake Hills has a dense, dark garnet color. Rich and round on the palate with dark fruit entry, smooth tannins and a long smooth finish.
- Climbing Cabernet – Australia – 2004 32
Deeply colored, with bright red and black fruit aromas packed with complex flavors. **GLS**
- Ehler's Estate -120 over 80 Napa Cabernet 2007 78
This 80% Cabernet 14% Merlot and 6% Petit Verdot blend was created to show the vast diversity of Ehler's 23 vineyards. A big French plum starts with a silky middle and a complex long finish.
- Sutcliffe Vineyards – Cabernet – McElmo Canyon, Colorado 2006 52
Sun drenched days, crisp, cool nights give this cabernet wonderful complexity and a beautiful depth.
Very smooth with a beautiful finish.



Zinfandel

- Brazin Zinfandel – “Sommer Vineyard” - Dry Creek Valley 2007** 48
 One of Dry Creeks finest Zinfandels showing intense dark fruit, brown spices and earthy notes. Bold luscious tannins come from the hand picking late in the season. Step up to this “Giant Zin”.
- Quickfire Zinfandel – Dry Creek Valley 2006** 40
 This Zinfandel was crafted by the Terlato Family for the popular TV show Top Chef. The color is a rich, dark rose. The nose captures blackberry fruit. Anise, blueberry and black cherry notes flow through on the palate.
- Villa Mt. Eden Antique Vines – Amador and Napa Valley's 2005** 50
 Zesty ripe raspberries, creamy vanillin oak and spicy brambly mature fruit characteristics. 76% of the grapes come from Amador County and 24% from the Napa Valley. Best of both!
- Ravenswood “Big River” Zinfandel – Alexander Valley 2006** 60
 This Zinfandel has almost pure characteristics of Old Vine Zinfandel with a combination of concentration, complexity, and a richness that is unsurpassable. This wine is big, round and berry filled, with jammy and raspberry characteristics. Beautiful long drawn out finish.

Pinot Noir

- Brophy Clark Lindsay's Vineyard Pinot Noir – Santa Rita Hills 2007** 48
 A very low production wine of only 285 cases aged 14 months in 40% new French oak small Barrels, this Pinot Noir is very fruity with bold flavors of rhubarb, pomegranate, and raspberry
- Vine Hill – Santa Cruz Mountains - 2008** 34
 Cherry, blackberry, and raspberry aromas cross with hints of chocolate, dusty earth, and white pepper on the nose.
- Axis Cellars Pinot Noir – Russian River Valley 2006** 45
 Strawberry, Raspberry and Nutmeg on the nose with baking spice on the palate and a long lingering fresh ripe fruit finish. Great Pinot – great value
- Buena Vista Pinot Noir – “Ramal Vineyard” – Carneros - 2006** 66
 Medium violet hue. Ripe flavors of black cherry and red raspberry with hints of caramel and maple. Full tannins and impressions of plum and sandalwood in the finish. Very complex and special.
- Miura Pinot Noir – “Williams Ranch Vineyard” Anderson Valley 2006** 42
 Lovely fresh red cherry and berry fruit forward wine. Nice medium Pinot fresh and balanced.

Syrah/Shiraz and Blended Varietals

- Markham Petite Syrah – Napa Valley 2004** 45
 This 100% petite syrah is aged 40 months in French and American oak and offers a bouquet is full of Violets, plum and blackberry. Finished with white pepper and spice.
- Gloria Ferrer Estate Syrah – Carneros 2003** 34
 Saturated Black Fruit and focused structural qualities. Excellent spice and subtle smoke notes. Flavors of white pepper, violet and cassis with a balanced acidity so essential to a great Syrah.
- Jacobs Creek Shiraz – South Eastern Australia 2008** **Magnum Bottle** 65
 A medium bodied Shiraz with plum, pepper and spicy fruit flavors with subtle hints of toasted oak. A Magnum bottle is equal to 2 regular bottles. Special Buy!
- Kunde Estate Syrah – Sonoma Valley 2006** 30
 This wine is full and rich like Cabernet but with a softer tannin structure. Bold jammy, blackberry flavors are enhanced with a subtle spicy component. It Retail for \$23. Bought this wine at a great price !
- Ramos Pinto Adriano – Duoro Valley, Portugal- 2006** 29
 Varietal blend of Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz and Touriga Nacional. Adriano is a wine with fresh fruit flavors, rich complexity and excellent balance. Something different, fresh and well priced. **GLS**
- Burgess Cellars Napa Valley Syrah 2005** 38
 WS. Intense, focused, with lively berry flavors. Full bodied, with a nice rustic minerally edge. Hard to find, delicious to drink. A price to celebrate!
- Quinta do Carmo – Portugal 2001** 36
 This old estate is now owned by the Rothschild family (Laffite). A blend of Portuguese varietals Argonez, Alicante and Trincadeira with Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon. Intense ruby color. Blackberry and blackcurrant. Muscular with lots of dark plum and cassis.

John's Special selection wine list

I have chosen these wines for their high quality and unique flavors as well as passing along to you some very reasonably priced delicious wines.

Whites

Louis Jadot Chablis – France 2006 36

This wine is from house of Mason Jadot which was founded in Beaune, France in 1859. Nice Golden-yellow color. Bright and fresh with taste and bouquet that develop rather quickly.

Davis Bynum Chardonnay – Russian River Valley 2010 48

Heralded as the best chardonnay to appear under the Davis Bynum label, this wine has keen Fruity focus along with a fine sense of balance and its oak and mineral extras make for a truly Extraordinary chardonnay

Ovation Chardonnay – Freestone Vineyard Napa Valley 2006 60

The first vintage since 2004, 100% Chardonnay from western Napa Valley, brings a lemon core, fig and cream along with the mineral and spice characteristic of this region

Grgich Hills Estate Chardonnay - Carneros 2005 65

This estate wine is grown using sustainable farming practices. These practices grow balanced, healthy vines which maintain exceptional flavors. You will detect notes of lemon zest, flowers and honey with a hint of crushed stones. This is a complex Chardonnay.

Reds

Sanford Pinot Noir – Santa Rita Hills 2007 50

Fragrant roses, raspberries and cherries with a touch of tobacco. A nice fruity Pinot with supple tannins and a long smooth finish.

Davis Bynum Pinot Noir – Russian River Valley 2010 54

A delicious Pinot Noir to drink now. Soft and savory, it shows appealing raspberry, cherry and spice flavors, accented with the vanilla and toast of oak. 90 points on Wine Spectator

Williams Selyem Pinot Noir – Russian River Valley 2008 95

The nose is of blackberries, plums, toffee, and crème brûlée. The rich and full tannins accentuate blackberry and dark plum flavors, and complement the creamy, silky finish. One of the best.

Philip Shaw No. 17 – Merlot- Cab.- Cab. Franc – Australia 2004 36

Deep ruby. Pungent black fruit and cedar aromas complicated by tobacco and espresso. Lush and sweet with cassis and blackberry flavors tinged with notes of fresh herbs.

Rodney Strong Merlot – Sonoma County 2008 36

Plum and blueberry flavors with a touch of dried herb predominate in this soft, rich, mouth filling merlot. Plum and blueberry flavors are enhanced by aging in small oak barrels for a toasty, spicy vanilla character, and a lingering berry-cream finish.

Duckhorn Merlot – Napa Valley 2008 62

Classic Bordeaux blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Verdot and Cabernet Franc. Asian spice, red currant, plum and blueberry. This is a huge Napa Merlot.

Gundlach Bundschu Cabernet – Sonoma Valley 2005– Estate Vineyard 72

Intense aromas of black currant and cassis laced with notes of black spice and ground coffee. On the palate, flavors of blackberry and black currant appear. 92% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Petite Verdot. A big jammy wine. Retail for \$72. Great price for a great wine !

BV "Georges De Latour" Private Reserve Cabernet – Napa 2005 150

Immense layers of blackberry, black cherry and dark plum with hints of mocha, anise, and vanilla. This special reserve has a beautiful medium full bodied style with perfect flavors. \$95 retail!

Ravenswood Vineyards "Pickberry" Claret Sonoma Mountain 05 94

The blackberry saturated hillsides lend their tremendous flavor to the dramatic fruit and nose on this wine. 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet with sensual dark cherry, plum and mocha.

Ballentine Vineyards Napa "Maple Lane" Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 46

92 % Cab, 4% Cab. Franc and 4%Petit Verdot make this classic Claret. Cherry, blueberry and black pepper. Fruit forward with a long complex finish. This is an amazing wine. Big and bold. I bought 20 cases of this wine at a special price. It retails for \$43 so don't miss out.

Burgess Napa Valley – Cabernet – Library Release - 1996 120

Dark garnet, cassis, black and red currants, sweet spice and undertones of earth, cedar and a hint of chocolate. Medium full - bodied, with moderate tannins and a nice finish. This classic Cabernet is a limited library release.

Domaine Terlato & Chapoutier–Malakoff, South Eastern Australia 2006 45

Collaboration and location make this a very special wine. Chapoutier make some of the best Rhone wines. Napa winemaker Terlato teamed up and they have made a spectacular wine from grapes grown in the Malakoff vineyard of Australia. Complex with black fruit aromas and undertones of chocolate.
